The 2016-17 season will be Richard's fourteenth as Director of the Leicester Bach Choir. He is also Music Director of Leicestershire Schools Symphony Orchestra, Nottingham Harmonic Choir, Leamington Chamber Orchestra, the Bach Camerata and

Cambridgeshire Choral Society, Principal Guest Conductor of Birmingham Philharmonic Orchestra, and Associate Conductor of Chandos Symphony Orchestra. He began his career as Conducting Scholar at Birmingham Conservatoire, where after nine months of study he was awarded his Masters Degree, a Postgraduate Diploma, and the Postgraduate Prize for the most outstanding contribution to the musical life of the college. Shortly thereafter he was appointed to the post of Associate Conductor with the virtuoso young ensemble Sinfonia Cymru.

As a Chorus Master Richard frequently prepares choirs for Britain's top orchestras. Recently he has prepared *The Music Makers* and *The Planets* for the Hallé under Sir Mark Elder, Александр Невский for the Hallé with Cristian Mandeal, and *Carmina Burana* for the BBC Symphony Orchestra and Gergely Madaras. This season includes choral preparation of *Belshazzar's Feast* for the Hallé and Rory Macdonald.


